Ardaaga at a Glance:

Ardaaga is a non-profit organization dedicated to strengthening democracy in Somalia. Founded in 2020 as Kismaayo Debates, the organization initially focused on fostering public discussions to encourage critical thinking and civic dialogue. However, recognizing the need for deeper community engagement and actionable solutions, the organization evolved into Ardaaga in late 2021. The name "Ardaaga," inspired by Somali cultural heritage, symbolizes a communal space for discussions, decision-making, and resolutions.

This rebranding marked a pivotal shift toward a holistic approach, integrating civic engagement, leadership development, research, and policy advocacy to empower communities and influence governance reforms. Over the years, Ardaaga has expanded its reach by forming strategic partnerships, launching impactful initiatives such as the Sahanka Madaniga (civic engagement program) and the Hogaanbile leadership development initiative, and advocating for policies that promote transparency and inclusivity.

Through civic engagement, research, leadership development, policy advocacy, and cultural heritage preservation, Ardaaga continues to strengthen governance, promote informed participation, and ensure that all voices—especially marginalized communities—are heard in shaping Somalia's future.

Strategic Objectives

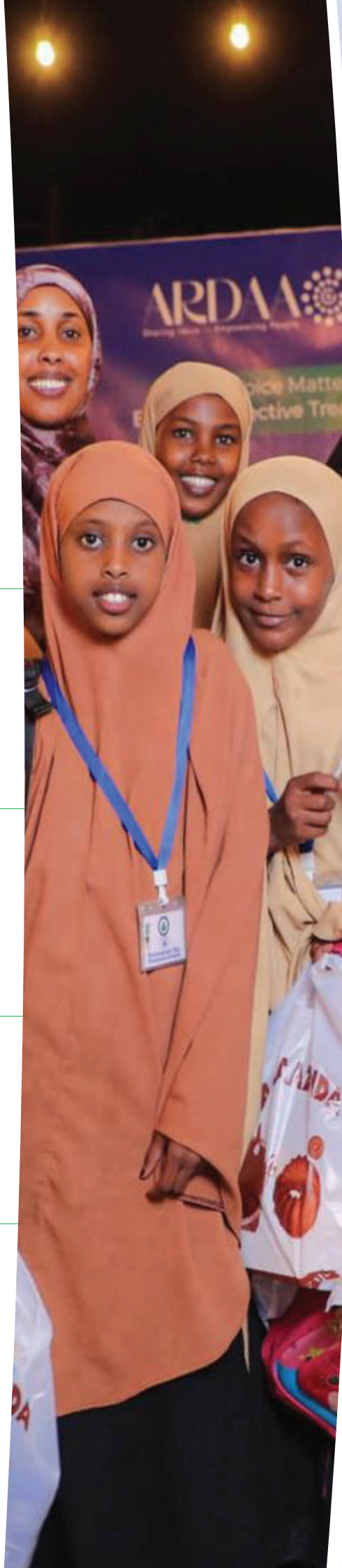

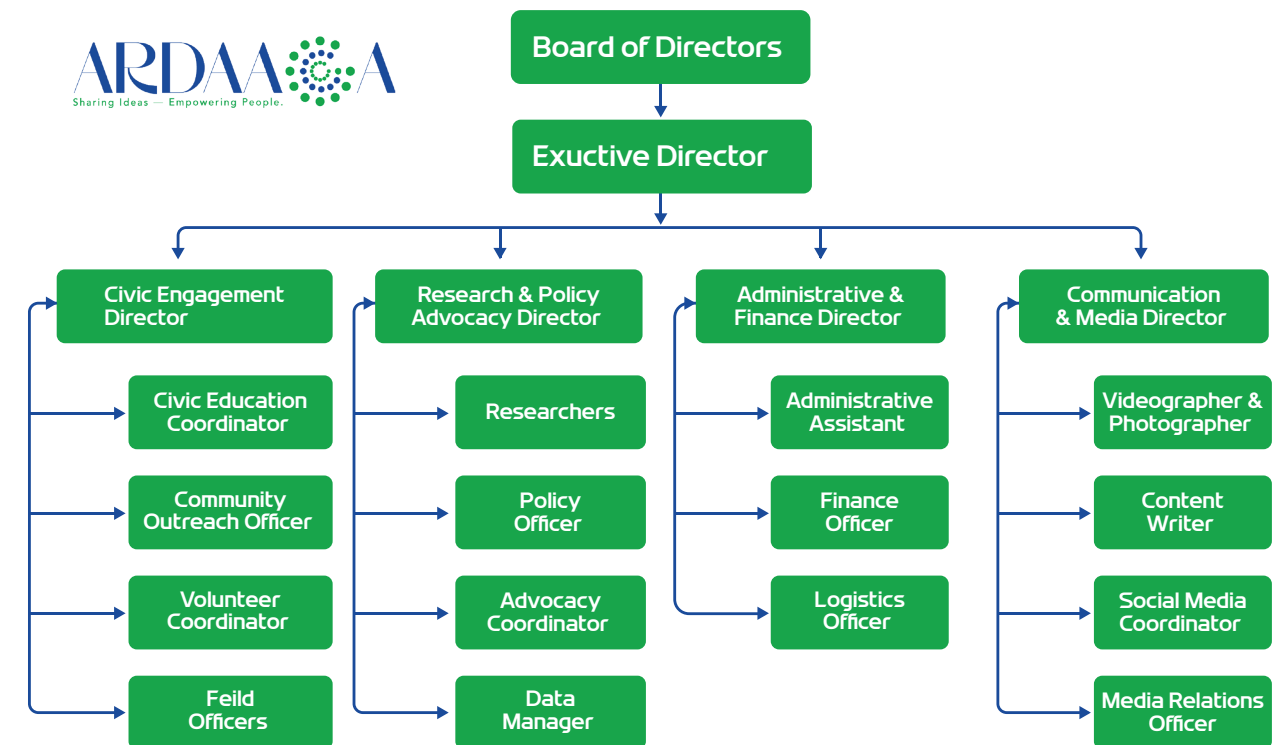

Future Roadmap:

Ardaaga envisions a phased approach to expanding its impact, with clear short-term and long-term priorities:

Short-Term Goals (Next 1-3 Years):

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| 01 | Expand civic engagement programs to more communities, particularly in underserved regions. |
| 02 | Strengthen research and advocacy efforts by publishing more policy recommendations and engaging decision-makers. |
| 03 | Develop a leadership training framework and pilot programs to nurture young and emerging leaders. |
| 04 | Enhance digital platforms for civic education, increasing accessibility and interactivity. |
| 05 | Strengthen existing partnerships and create new alliances to support immediate programmatic needs. |

Long-Term Goals (Next 4-10 Years):

- 01 Establish permanent leadership training centers across Somalia to cultivate ethical governance at all levels.
- 02 Institutionalize civic education by integrating it into school curriculums and community programs.
- 03 Expand research capabilities to create a dedicated policy think tank supporting governance reforms.
- 04 Foster cross-regional collaborations, engaging more international partners to align with global best practices.
- 05 Ensure financial sustainability through diverse funding models, including grants, private sector partnerships, and self-sustaining initiatives.
